The Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act (RLUIPA) was passed by Congress and became federal law in 2000. One of the intents of the Act was to prevent zoning laws from substantially interfering with the rights of religious assemblies and institutions to use their property in the fulfillment of their missions.

The New Jersey Municipal Land Use Law (N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1 et. seq.) permits a municipality to adopt a zoning ordinance and development regulations that control where and how land uses may be developed, including houses of worship. How have municipalities been attempting to regulate modern, multi-use religious complexes, and when do these rules place a “substantial burden” on religious exercise?

This webinar will explore the relationship between RLUIPA and the MLUL, and the relevant federal and New Jersey case law will be discussed.
